

NORTHERN ONTARIO 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION

DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM INFRACTION POLICY

- 1) Each team must be dressed uniformly. Individuals on a team must wear bottoms in the same colour (black) but each may wear a different length/style bottom.
- 2) The Zone Association colours will be as follows:

Cambrian North - Steel Blue & Grey Gateway - Green, White and Black Gold Belt - Royal Blue with White Nickel District - Navy with Gold Thunder Bay District - Vintage Red, Black, Grey & White Sunset Country - Black & Yellow

- 3) Uniforms may include undershirt/t-shirt sleeve in main zone colour or black and if more than one (1) they must be the same colour.
- 4) During any Provincial tournament that any Coach/Manager or in the case of the OPEN Provincial – the bowler sitting out be permitted to wear a long sleeve sweater/cardigan in either their team colour or black in the playing area during the tournament.
- 5) C5 rules governing uniforms will apply including: No hats or caps or other headgear are allowed unless worn for religious or medical reasons. Exception: women are allowed to wear basic black leggings (no rips, patterns, etc.) for the provincial round only.
- 6) That the amount of sponsorship space on a competing bowler's shirt be increased to include the whole area of both sleeves, minus the area where the logo and name of the bowler may be located.
- 7) When competitors are out of uniform during competition at any provincial event the affected zone will be fined \$25 per day per infraction. There must be an official letter of protest for this ruling to be applied. The competitor will be given a reasonable amount of time prior to being fined to get the appropriate attire.
- 8) The official letter of protest is to be brought to the Tournament Committee. To be reviewed, the complaint must be made by a Zone Contingent Manager. If the complaint is deemed valid, the Tournament Committee will address the situation with the affected zones manager.
